- Earn Professional Developmental Units.

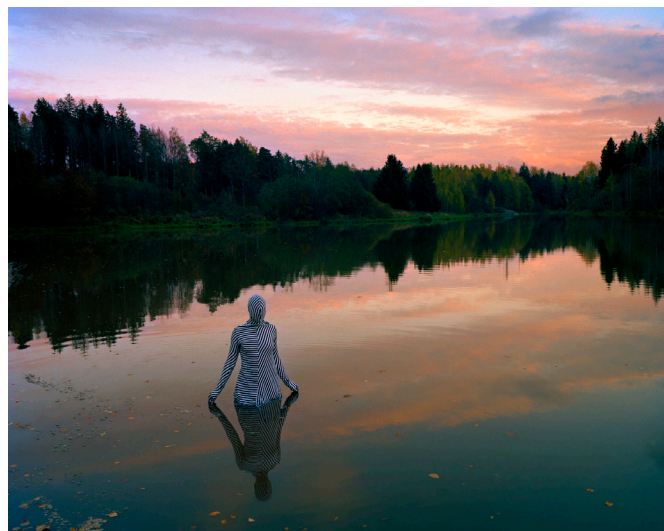

Nine Trips Around the Sun is the largest and most comprehensive presentation of Carrie Schneider's photographs and films to date. Spanning the years 2006 through 2015, the 59 works offer a survey of the artist's self-described "documents of something performed for the camera" and demonstrate the range of lens-based processes she has employed.

Schneider's work has been exhibited in solo presentations at the Museum of Contemporary Art, Chicago; Finnish Museum of Photography, Helsinki; and Mattress Factory, Pittsburgh; among others. She has received awards from Creative Capital and the Joan Mitchell Foundation, and was a Fulbright Fellow at Academy of Fine Arts, Helsinki. Schneider received her BFA from Carnegie Mellon University and her MFA from The School of the Art Institute of Chicago. She lives in Brooklyn and is represented by Monique Meloche Gallery, Chicago.
