Look for the paper with lines of the artist's heartbeat. With a partner, discuss why you think the artist has presented a medical record as an artwork. In what ways does this artwork connect with other works and ideas in the exhibition?
Go to the large photograph of the artist holding a hand-written note in front of his face. In the space below, write about what this image makes you think and feel. Does your ability to read the text in the image impact your thoughts or feelings?	GALLERIES of Illinois State University	Search for the photograph with a white orb surrounded by darkness. The title of the exhibition is based on ways this artwork might be interpreted. Write a list of things that you think this image could represent.
Search for the four small, black-framed artworks. The title of this project, Shards, is from a poem by Jay Hopler titled Family Astrology. Search for and describe ways the artwork relates to the title of Hopler's poem. If you were to make an artwork in response to a book or poem, which book or poem would you choose?	Go to the small, black-and-white photographs of the artist with his eyes closed. When the artist took these self-portraits, he was imagining what his life might have looked like if he had stayed in Peru rather than moving to the United States. What do you imagine another version of your life would look like? How is it similar to or different from your current life?	Find the large photographs of people with their eyes closed. Based on what you see, describe what you think they might have been thinking or feeling when the photos were taken.
